

HOMEOWNER TIP - HOT WATER HEATER MAINTENANCE

Did you know, you should "FLUSH" your Hot Water Heater at least once per year to help prevent early failure due to sediment build-up at the bottom of the tank.

It is simple to do.....at the bottom of the tank (near the thermostat) is a "Hose Bib" faucet just like on the side of your house which is used for sprinkling, etc. All you have to do is connect a hose to the "Hose Bib" and open the valve for 2 minutes to drain the water from the bottom of the tank. Than, close the valve and wait 5 minutes for the tank to refill. Repeat 4 times.
